Spend an extra 20 minutes on one of the following. Make sure you are completing lessons. (Strive for Accuracy and Completion)	: Create an advertisement to get people to attend a carnival! Try to write at least five lines. Include what will be there like food, games, rides, and more! (Finding Humor)	Practice tying your "Clown" shoe. (Persisting)
Write a letter or draw a picture to a nurse who you or someone in your family appreciates! (Thinking and Communicating with Clarity and Precision)	Create your own ring toss. Label the bottles with numbers. Throw your "ring" 3 times and create a math equation to go along with those numbers. (Striving For Accuracy)	Listen to Olivia and the School Carnival. Pause at different times to talk about what you notice and wonder. Write to retell the story but change the characters and setting to fit your carnival. (Thinking About Your Thinking)
Go on a sight word search! Search around your house on products, books, or other places and see if you can find these sight words. Write/draw where you found them. Then try to use them in a sentence. Sight Words: water, ride, play, fun, come (see how many you can use on your advertisement; box 2) (Responding with Wonderment and Awe)	Create a "carnival tent" using items around your house! The size depends on your design! Don't forget to add lots of color and imagination when making your design and prototype! (Creating, Imagining, Innovating)	Create a carnival game or ride! Use your imagination to design something that you and your family can play together! (Creating, Imagining, Innovating)
Discuss one of your favorite memories you have from a carnival or amusement park! If you've never been, imagine what you'd like to do and discuss with your family! Maybe even add a virtual ride on a rollercoaster or trip to an amusement park! (Listening with Understanding and Empathy)	Create an estimation jar! Fill a jar with an object around the house (cotton balls, buttons, etc.) Without counting, try and guess how many objects fit into your jar!
